The OpenSSF and the Linux Foundation Address Software Supply Chain Security Challenges at White House Summit

WASHINGTON (January 13, 2022) Today marks an important moment in the Linux Foundation's history of engagement with public sector organizations. The White House convened an important cross-section of the Open Source developer and commercial ecceystem along with leaders and experts of many U.S. federal agencies to identify the challenges present in the open source software supply chain and share ideas on ways to mitigate risk and enhance reallence.

At the meeting, the Linux Foundation and the Open Source Security Foundation (OpenSSF) represented their hundreds of communities and projects by highlighting collective cybersecurity efforts and sharing their intent to work with the administration across public and naivate sectors:

What will FINOS do for its projects?

Committed (via OKRs):

- Include (and roll out) <u>OpenSSF Best Practices Badge</u> in <u>Project Lifecycle</u> requirements for incubating and active projects
- 2. **Accelerate roll out of existing** mandatory security scanning (currently using Whitesource, looking at **LFX Security**) to all projects

Opportunistic (but very possible with your help)

- 1. Goal for 2022 of publishing <u>SPDX SBOMs</u> and consuming them from dependencies
- 2. Maintainers training:
 - a. Maintainers, as part of their responsibilities, to take the <u>free EdX courses on secure software</u> <u>development</u>. This is just like asking speakers at our events to take DEI training an ounce of prevention, etc.
 - b. Promote multi-factor auth tokens at every stage of the development lifecycle
- 3. Ensure focus on open source consumption as part of the Open Source Readiness Initiative






