

HTC-Grid

Contributed to FINOS by Amazon Web Services

The high throughput compute grid project (HTC-Grid) is a container based cloud native HPC/Grid environment.

The project provides a reference architecture that can be used to build and adapt a modern High throughput compute solution using underlying AWS services, allowing users to submit high volumes of short and long running tasks and scaling environments dynamically.

Objectives



Why?

- Increasing market volatility, regulatory requirements, and aging hardware pose challenges to Financial Services Institutions (FSI) to operate and scale HPC workloads on-premises.
- FSIs chose cloud native options when it comes to cloud migration and modernisation.

What?

 We released HTC-Grid as a reusable blueprint that provides a reference architecture for a modern container based HTC solution that uses common cloud services, addresses the challenges, and outlines a modernisation path.

How?

- Compute grids built using the HTC-Grid blueprint are currently running in production in multiple European Banks.
- Operational characteristics include scalability beyond 80,000 vCPUs and throughput above 30,000 tasks/second.






